Rosedell Students to Open Enrollment Schools:

If you plan on sending your children to an OPEN ENROLLMENT School you would fill out the "General Intra-District Transfer" form on the district's website or pick up a copy from our office. You would return the form to our Rosedell office no later than March 12th.

Rosedell Students to West Creek Academy:

Forms are available on the District's web site and in Rosedell's office. Fill out West Creek Transfer form and return to the District Office between February 22-March 12 (9:00-4:00).
